

Elementary profile of school

The school of SOŠZ a SOU Český Krumlov is a state-founded institution, established by the Region of South Bohemia and provides secondary education finished with a school leaving exam in fields: a medical assistant and social work, and secondary education finished with an apprenticeship certificate in fields: a cook-waiter, a shop assistant, a bricklayer, a joiner, a tinsmith, a house painter, a carpenter, a roofer, a plumber and a newly established field nursing care.

Our school was established in 1991 as The Secondary school for medical assistants and in previous years it was merged with a modern equipped professional training centre in Český Krumlov and a joiner's workshop in Chvalšiny.

Apart from providing professional experience and training the school regularly organizes other educational activities and special courses (excursions to foreign countries, sports courses, a bartending course for waiters, a fruit and vegetables engraving course for cooks) and short-term seminars and lectures. The students and apprentices regularly take part in professional competitions of regional and republic ranges, in which they achieve good results. The school also takes part in different project activities, especially in the projects of the European social fund, the projects connected with principal socio-pathological phenomena prevention, environmental education and cross-border cooperation.

In the region of South Bohemia there is a strong interest in qualified bricklayers, carpenters, shop assistants, cooks, waiters and waitresses, social workers and medical assistants. Most of them continue their studying at colleges or universities. Apprentices can get secondary education finished with a school leaving exam in follow-up study programmes.
